May 1, 1973	Listed on Korea Stock Exchange
May 1, 1976	Became first Korean insurer to market Insurance for liability policy for motorists
Jan. 1, 1981	Became first Korean non-life insurer to introduce an online system
May 10, 1983	Acquired Korea Auto Insurance by Dongbu Group
Dec. 31, 1983	Began to market 21 non-life insurance products, including Fire
Feb. 1, 1984	Began to cover all non-life insurance products, except payment guarantees
